

# GET INVOLVED IN NET



In the event of a citywide or regional emergency such as a severe winter storm, flood or major earthquake, households need to be prepared to be on their own for at least two weeks, or even longer. Neighborhoods need to be prepared for self-sufficiency, too. Volunteer neighborhood rescuers will likely be first on the scene when firefighters and police are slowed by impassable streets or overwhelmed by calls for help.

NET Members live or work in Portland and receive instruction from Portland Bureau of Emergency Management and Portland Fire & Rescue to provide emergency disaster assistance within their own neighborhoods. NET Members are prepared to save lives and property until police, fire, and EMS responders can arrive. These volunteers are specially trained to help others without putting themselves in harm's way.
